Tasks to be completed include: Moving furniture/cupboards from the storeroom, painting cream bench seating, sweeping, cobwebs and weeding.

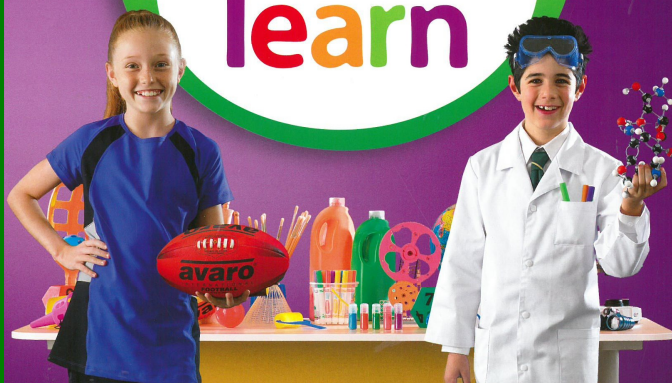
