

The Inquiry Learning unit for this semester is an investigation of 'Business and Economics'. This term the focus will be running a business and selling some of their products at the Mini Bazaar. Students are continuing to enjoy investigating this unit of work through Reading, Writing and S.T.E.M.


students arrive in time to take advantage of this important start to our day.
