It is vital that the children read daily at home and are encouraged for their efforts. Please continue to regularly practise reading the words from the list inside the reader covers.




## Science & STEM


Our topic for Science this term is 'Spot the Difference'. The focus of this topic is Chemical Sciences and about how everyday materials can be physically changed in a variety of ways. The children will look closely at changes in food once heated or cooled. Children will also plan, design and construct their own spaghetti tower. We will also have a STEM incursion towards the end of term - stay tuned for more details.

## Writing

During term 3, the children will learn some new vocabulary based on the 6+1 Traits of Writing. The traits include ideas, organisation, voice, word choice, sentence fluency, conventions and presentation. During the term, we will also focus on persuasive writing. We will learn about persuasive ideas, structure and powerful word choice. During the last few weeks of the term, the children will write a persuasive text and go through all the steps of the writer's process.







#### Mathematics

This term we will cover a range of topics in Mathematics. Some of topics will include money, time, mass, transformation (flip, slide and turn), multiplication, division, fractions and graphs. It is vital the students revisit these topics throughout the year as they need to consolidate on their learning.

#### Homework

Number facts should continue to be practised each night, and the sheets must be brought to school every Friday. The sight vocabulary at the back of the reader covers should also be practised on a regular basis.
