School Concert

6+1 Traits of Writing

This term, we have launched our new writing program, '6+1 Traits of Writing'. Over the duration of the term, students will explore each trait in detail and use the traits to analyse their own and other's writing. It has been wonderful to see students already using the 6+1 Traits vocabulary to discuss writing.

6+1 Traits: Ideas, Organisation, Voice, Word Choice, Sentence Fluency, Conventions and Presentation.

Natural Disasters

Our inquiry unit for Term 3 is 'Natural Disasters'. During this unit, students will develop their understanding of the term, 'natural disaster', and explore how different disasters are caused, where they occur as well as the impacts they have on society. Students will also investigate warning systems and methods for prevention for potential disasters.



Students will be exploring natural disasters through a range of curriculum areas including Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Science, Art, Information Technology and Design Technology.

Class Dojo

Class Dojo has been set up so that you are able to connect with your child's learning and communicate with myself. Make sure you are

Regular and punctual attendance is extremely important for your child's learning! All absences must be covered by a note or a phone call from home. Please inform the office of any extended absences or holidays outside of the regular school holiday periods.

Term 3 Rotations

Each class will have a two week block with each of the following rotations this term. Rotations are on Fridays 11:10am - 12:50pm.



WEBSITES: Students will learn the features of a website and understand how different types of websites are structured. Students will have the opportunity to create their own website, based on a personal interest, by incorporating elements such as text, titles, navigation menus, images and videos.

COMING: Students will be working in teams to follow recipes and use fresh ingredients to make healthy snacks. They will learn the importance of hygiene when preparing food, how to use kitchen tools carefully and responsibly, and how to read and follow instructions in recipes. Students will bring a notice home regarding cost for this rotation.





DIGITAL MEDIA: Students will have the opportunity to explore two new iPad apps: Stop Motion Animation and iMovie with Green Screen. Students will learn the techniques of animation and how to utilise digital resources for filming.

PERFORMING ARTS: Students will participate in improvisation activities and learn to use movement, emotions and voice to create and communicate a character's intentions. Students will also work cooperatively with their peers to rehearse and perform scripted drama to engage an audience.



Homework

Homework tasks are as follows:

Reading minimum 20 minutes every evening

• Spelling four points worth of activities each week

• Maths minimum two nights a week on study ladder

• **Projects** due every three weeks
