# Reading

Please continue to listen to your child read their take home book and the M100 words every night. Most children are progressing very well, and whilst we award certificates to students when all the words are known, some children will go on to new words in order to expose them to a range of high frequency words. Please make sure to revise all the M100 words to reinforce their learning.



## Show and Tell

This term Show and Tell will continue on Friday afternoons. We have sent home a schedule of when students will have their turn to present their item and what they should bring in that week. Each week's show and tell topic is based on what we are focusing on in class in order to reinforce students' learning.

We encourage all children to share something with their classmates on their Show and Tell day. It is important that all children "have a go" at speaking in front of the class in this setting as it gives them the opportunity to further develop their

confidence and public speaking skills.

Please help your child to prepare for these sessions by discussing their item and what they will talk about. This helps the children to become more confident when speaking in front of peers and adults.
