Inquiry Unit

This term we will be focussing on Geography in a unit entitled, 'A Diverse and Connected World'. Students will explore the connections Australia has with other countries across the world, including

countries our families have emigrated from and countries of the Asia region. They will learn about the diversity of the world's people, including the indigenous peoples of other countries and explore and reflect upon similarities, differences and the importance of intercultural understanding.



Homework Projects

This term homework will be in the form of mini projects. Students will have 3 weeks to complete each project and they are encouraged to be creative with how they present them. These projects will include a Writing, Reading and Science Project.



Students will also have Spelling and Maths homework to support their learning of the skills being explored at school as well as 20 minutes of reading each night.
