Science

This Term, students are learning about Earth and Space Sciences through the topic of 'Night and Day'. Students will learn about shadows - how and why they occur as well as thinking about what changing shadows tell us about the movement of the Earth. Students will also learn about how the Earth spins on its axis and orbits around the Sun.

Civics & Citizenship

This semester the students are exploring the journey of a significant world navigator, Captain Cook and stories of the First Fleet. They will be investigating the causes and reasons for the journey and looking at the different experiences and perspectives following their arrival in Australia.

Health / Cooking

This term for Health we are covering Personal Hygiene, focusing on looking after our health by keeping clean and brushing our teeth.

We will be cooking strawberry cupcakes, learning to read and follow a recipe, measuring the ingredients and cooking the cupcakes. **The students will need to bring along \$3 to help pay for the ingredients and a container on their cooking day.**

ICT - During ICT this term, students have been exploring the Green Screen app on the iPads. Students looked at the features of Green Screen and used a step by step process to create a video. Working in groups, students found a background, based on their interests, and created a story that they wanted to film. Student had the opportunity to film their video in front of the Green Screen, located in the STEM room and share their end result with the class.

Homework

In Term 2, students will complete the following:

Maths - students will receive a weekly Maths homework sheet, focussing on quick recall of times tables facts. All children will benefit strongly from being able to recall multiplication facts up to 12 x1 2 by the time they complete Grade 4.

Word Study - students will bring home an activity sheet each week and a selection of words (to focus on the same word family over a 2 week block). Each night, the students will complete the activity for that day using their set words. Students are required to record the date and day they are completing it and the title of the activity in their Homework book.

Reading - students are expected to read every night and record it in the reading log inside their Reader Cover. Students are welcome to read books from the class Take Home Reader boxes, but they are also welcome to read and record other books - it's a great idea to visit your local library that your child can choose some exciting new books to read!
