

PARENT PAYMENTS POLICY NOVEMBER 2020

Dear Parent,

Clarinda Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our schools' parent payment arrangements for 2021.

The Department of Education provides funding to schools to hire staff and deliver the core curriculum. Consumables such as stationery items, handwriting books, computer leases and other resources are not paid for by the Government. All schools therefore need to raise additional funds locally by requesting a payment from each family.

Please find the fee schedule for 2021 attached.

Clarinda Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents whilst maintaining a high quality educational program. Parents are asked to contribute to the three categories explained below.

1. Essential Student Learning Items:

As the Government do not provide funds for stationery items, Clarinda Primary School purchases these in bulk and provides stationery to ALL children at the start of each school year and throughout the year as required. Each student will receive approximately 50 stationery items including but not limited to:

3. Optional Educational Items:

Our school offers a range of optional activities that are in addition to the delivery of the standard curriculum. These activities are designed to broaden the school experience for your child/children.

The Government does not provide funds for optional educational items. The cost of these activities will be advised during the course of the year and are provided on a user pays basis. These activities include excursions, incursions, camps, sleepovers, inter-school sport and swimming.

We greatly appreciate the excellent response from parents who support the school in its endeavours to provide the best possible educational experiences for all students and have over the years paid for their child/children's essential educational items. We understand that families may sometimes experience financial difficulty and we offer a range of support options, including;
