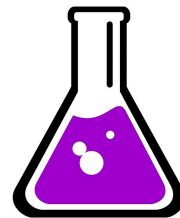


Interschool Sport

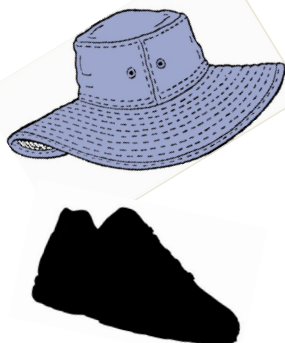
Science
