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## **ROTATIONS**

#### Science

This Term, students are learning about Physics through the topic of 'Magnets'. Students will learn about how magnets work and conduct experiments with their peers.

#### History

This term, the students will be exploring the journey of a significant world navigator, Captain Cook on his ship, The Endeavour. They will be investigating the route and reasons for his journey and how he navigated and mapped the coastline of Australia. Students will also complete their own online mission to learn about the different perspectives of the First Nation peoples and the crew of the Endeavour, after landing in Australia.

#### Geography

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This term for geography, students will be exploring neighbouring countries. Students will research to find information on New Zealand and Indonesia. Working in pairs, students will learn about vegetation, native animals, cultural celebrations and interesting landmarks in both countries.

#### ICT

During ICT this term, students will be exploring the Green Screen app on the iPads. Students will look at the features of Green Screen and use a step by step process to create a video. Working in groups, students will find a background, based on their interests, and create a story that they want to film.

### Homework

In Term 2, students will complete the following:

Maths - students will receive a weekly Maths
homework sheet, focussing on quick recall of times
tables facts. All children will benefit strongly from
being able to recall multiplication facts up to
12 x 12 by the time they complete Grade 4.

Reading - students are expected to read every
night and record it in the reading log inside their
Reader Cover. Students are welcome to read books
from the class Take Home Reader boxes, but they
are also welcome to read and record other books it's a great idea to visit your local library that your
child can choose some exciting new books to read!
