
2021 NAPLAN Results


In this week's newsletter I'd like to share with you a snapshot of our school's results in this year's national testing program (NAPLAN).

Students who participated in this year's NAPLAN testing will each receive an individual report from ACARA (Australian Curriculum, Assessment and reporting Authority). These are available for collection from the office. Any reports not collected prior to the end of term will be sent via Australia Post over the holidays.

It is important that this information is considered alongside the comprehensive student achievement data provided through the school's proficiency scales and student reports.

Today is officially R U OK? Day and, as a school, we would like to take this day to highlight how important it is to check in on one another and to have a focus on wellbeing.


We encouraged children to really get into the spirit of the day by wearing yellow.

Principal Class Take Over Day will also be an out of uniform day for Footy Colours Day. We would love to see our students dressed in their favourite colours.




End of Term 3 assembly
