SCIENCE - PUSH AND PULL

The Term 4 Science Unit is Push and Pull. Students will learn that there are different types of transport for different purposes. They will also classify transport by air, sea and land. They will investigate how the upward push of water or air on objects helps them to float in the water or air and that the downward pull of gravity on objects helps them to sink or fall. Students will identify the purpose for vehicle design and some of the problems that occur because of transport.

LITERACY

This term, in reading, students will read and view a range of texts by the author Aaron Blabey and explore the way Aaron Blabey uses language in his books. They will also identify the themes and messages Aaron Blabey books, and use comprehension strategies to think deeply when reading. Students will then explore a range of simple persuasive texts, understand the author's purpose is to persuade someone to do or think something, and identify the intended audience of a persuasive text.

In writing, students will explore the language and writing craft used by the author Aaron Blabey and model sentences using his writing style, to create, edit, revise and publish a narrative. Student will then write persuasive texts such as letters and posters with a focus on audience and purpose, using the Traits to make their writing more persuasive.

NUMERACY

Students will focus on a range of topics including: telling the time, multiplication & division, addition & subtraction, place value and fractions, ordering and counting money, describing number patterns and sequences, identify missing elements, and measuring area and capacity. We continue to provide students with opportunities to engage in real-world experiences and scenarios that involve mathematics that will help strengthen their understanding of mathematical concepts.

CROSS-LEVEL TRANSITION DAYS

Towards the end of this term, students will visit their classrooms for 2022 and meet their teachers for next year.
