Literacy

In Literacy this term, the Grade 3 & 4's are exploring the author, Margaret Wild, and a variety of her books. The students are also writing a picture book inspired by the writing style Margaret Wild uses.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, the students are looking at topics of data, length, perimeter, area, angles and money. Throughout these units, students are working on explaining their thinking and building on their problem-solving skills such as draw a diagram, write a number sentence or work backwards.

Rotations

All Grade 3/4 students will complete Rotation activities with each of the 3/4 teachers. They will work on each area for 2 weeks, before moving onto a new subject. This term Miss Ziebell & Mrs McNamee will be exploring Indigenous studies, Miss Delany will be teaching Science, Mrs Trumble will teach Geography and Miss Neaves Civics and Citizenship.

Homework

In Term 4, students are encouraged to complete the following:

<u>Maths</u> – students will receive a weekly Maths homework sheet, focussing on quick recall of times tables facts or division facts. All children will benefit strongly from being able to recall multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12 by the time they complete Grade 4.

<u>Reading</u> – students are expected to read every night and record it in the reading log inside their Reader Cover. Students are welcome to read books from the class Take Home Reader boxes, but they can also read and record other books. Students are encouraged to borrow books weekly from the school library which is regularly stocked with new and
