#### Welcome Back

I trust all of our students and families enjoyed a relaxing break and are ready to put their best foot forward in term four.

For the most part the weather was kind to us which hopefully enabled many families to enjoy the outdoors. Term 4 is always an extremely busy time and this term is no different.

We have the Graduation coming up, the Year 3/4 Camp, Christmas Concert, Prep Transition, Water Safety Swimming program and many more activities as well. Of course, between all of that our focus remains on providing the best possible learning outcomes for our students.

By ensuring we can provide a safe and happy learning environment that is well supported by the broader community, we go a long way to achieving this goal. I would remind families that reading is a daily homework expectation, but above that, reading for enjoyment is the best way to improve life outcomes, so please encourage your child to pick up a book as often as possible.

#### Holiday works

Over the holidays the school kept on ticking along, with the new outdoor learning area nearing completion. It looks fantastic and will allow more students to do their work in the open air.

All playgrounds have been topped up with new soft fall mulch. The new building decking has been cleaned along with all entry points and steps.

#### Hats

Now that Term 4 is upon us, all students are required to wear hats outdoors at all times. Students who forget their hat will be expected to stay in undercover areas close to their classroom. We would ask that all students use the uniform hat, which can be purchased through the school office at any time. It is also expected that our Year 5 & 6 students will demonstrate leadership by setting a good example for the younger students.

Communication was sent to all families on Monday about Class Placement for 2023. The communication can be accessed via Compass. Consideration will only be offered via accessing the provided link and completing necessary information to support your child/ren.

In 2023, the following structure will be in place:

- ♦ 3 x Prep (Foundation)
- ♦ 4 x Gr 1/2
- ♦ 4 x Gr 3/4
- ♦ 4 x Gr 5/6
- ♦ Physical Education (45 mins)
- ♦ LOTE Greek (45 mins)
- ♦ Music (45 mins)
- ♦ Art (45 min)
- ♦ STEM (45 min)
- ♦ Intervention & Extension Programs including the Tutoring program.

In addition to this structure, we will again support classrooms with integration aides to ensure that we have as many adults in learning spaces as possible.

The average class size across the school will be approximately 21.8 students with Prep classes anticipated at being 18 per class (certainly a great way to start learning at CPS as many neighbouring schools have 22-24 students per class).

We are hoping to ensure that our long-term average into the foreseeable future remains around this level.

It should be noted that schools are provided with one classroom space for every 25 students.

**2023 Enrolments for 3 and 4 year old programs**

As per my previous comments, now is the time to start enrolling your child for Links and Stepping Up for 2023. Over the last three years we have averaged roughly 20 applications for enrolment in Stepping Up and it is important for us to be able to plan for these programs. One of the most important aspects of this is understanding how many siblings will be enrolling in future years.

**Parents in the Classroom**

A reminder that parents are very welcome back in the classroom as parent helpers and may access the school grounds at any time to visit the office, whilst attending events or when volunteering in any capacity.

If you are keen to help hear some children read or volunteer for any of our upcoming events, such as the carols later in the year, please contact your classroom teacher so that we can arrange rosters or timetables as appropriate. All volunteers are required to provide a valid Working with Children Check to the office prior to volunteering.

As Covid restrictions are almost all removed, we will revisit our current policies at our next meeting later this month, before communicating any changes with the CPS community.

We have 3 students who qualified to compete at the Eastern Metropolitan Regional Championship on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October.

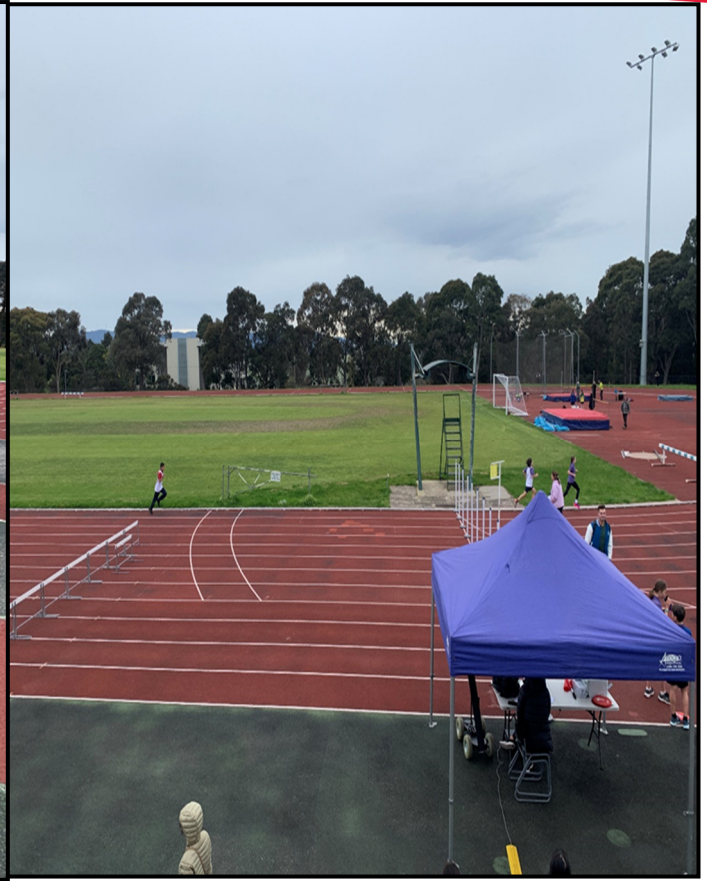

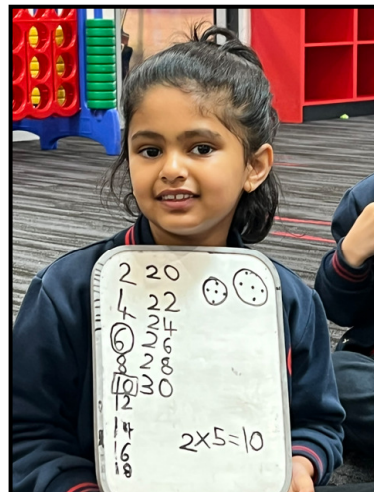
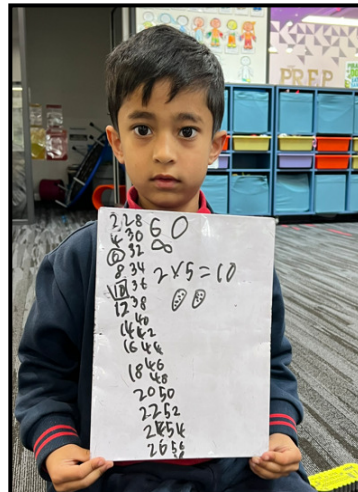
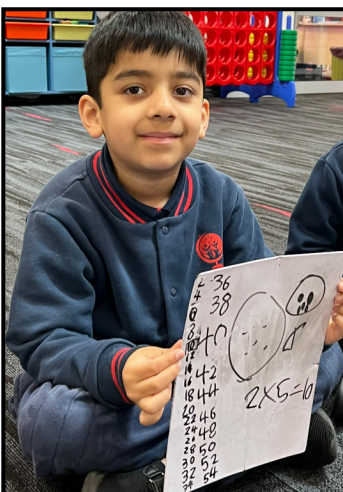
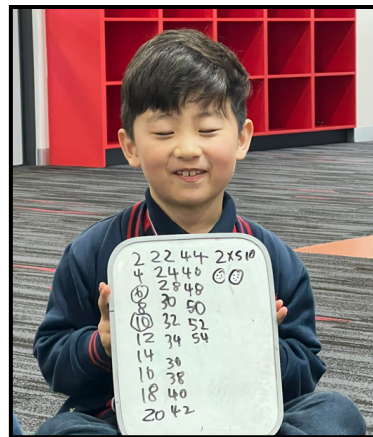
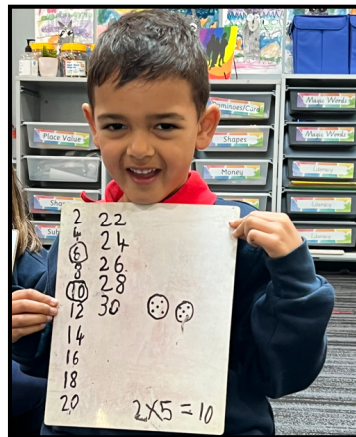
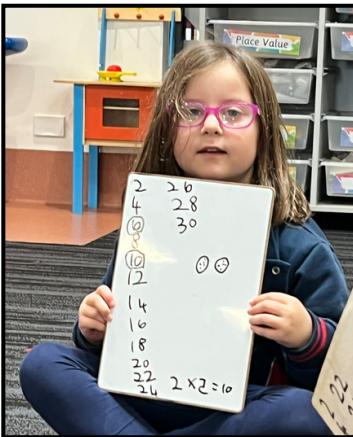
As a part of the CASP Program, students have been looking at Multiplication and what it means to create equal groups to make a number.

Students working on their 2X facts to make multiplication number sentences:

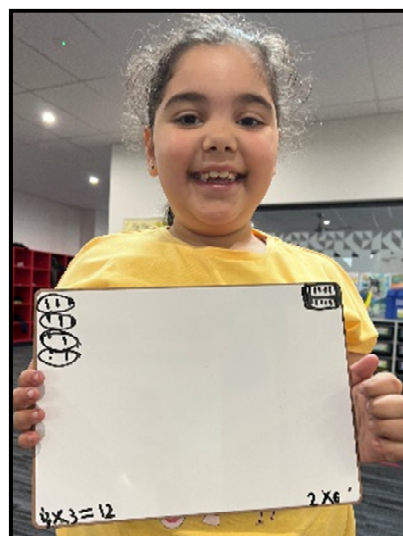
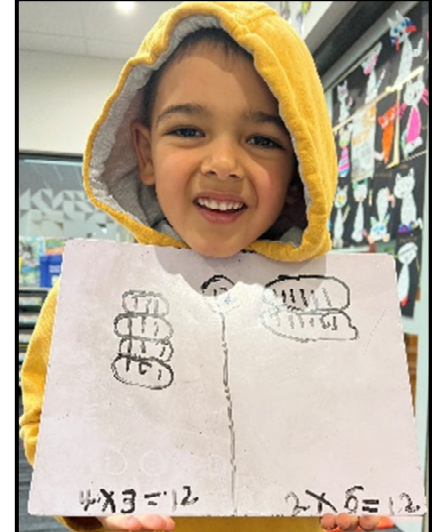
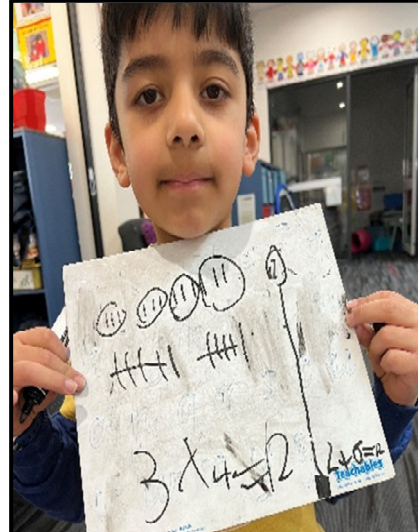
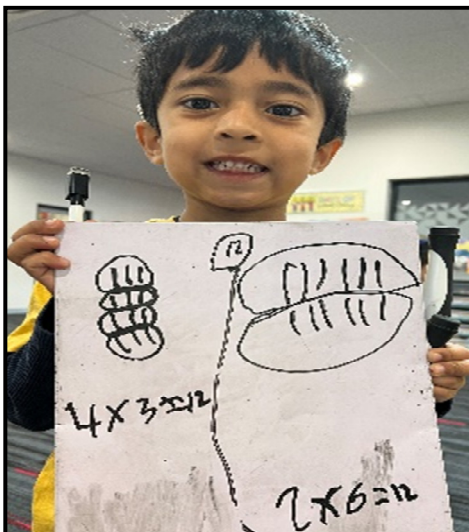

Also, Please do not forget to book your child for upcoming Pupil free Day: 11<sup>th</sup> October 2022 .

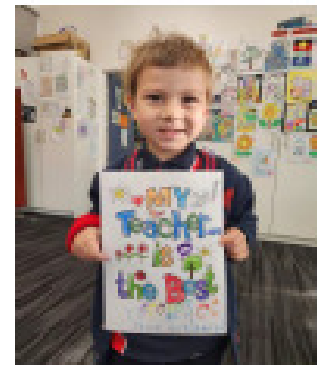

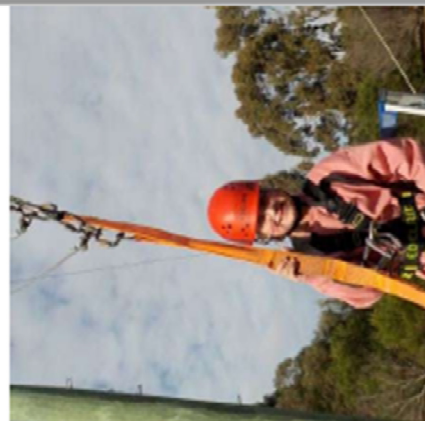

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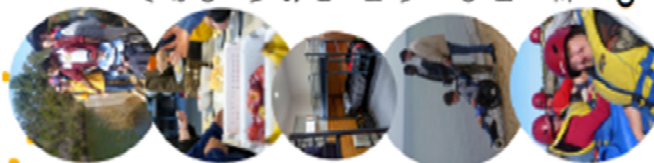
