Reading

Please continue to listen to your child read their take home book and revise the M100 words/alphabet every night. The children are progressing through the M100 words at their own pace and receive a certificate when they have achieved each list. In addition to this, we encourage you to make use of the Reading Eggs App at home, with particular emphasis on the Fast Phonics program. Please let us know if you need assistance accessing this program or if you need to be reissued with your child's login details.

Wellbeing

This term your child will continue to participate in the Play is the Way program each week. This school wide program assists your child to develop their social and emotional skills using guided play, classroom activities and an empowering language. The focus in Prep is on 'The Golden Rule: Treating Others As You Would Like to Be Treated.'

Science

The unit of study for this term is "On The Move" and our students will examine various ways that humans and toys can move. We will explore what parts help them move and introduce vocabulary such as push, pull, bounce, slide, roll and spin. On Thursday 8th June, the Prep students will apply this knowledge and participate in a 'Taskworks' Science Incursion. They will learn more about 'forces' through a series of practical and hands on activities.
