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Friday 2nd August – 100 Days of School, Foundation Dress up Day

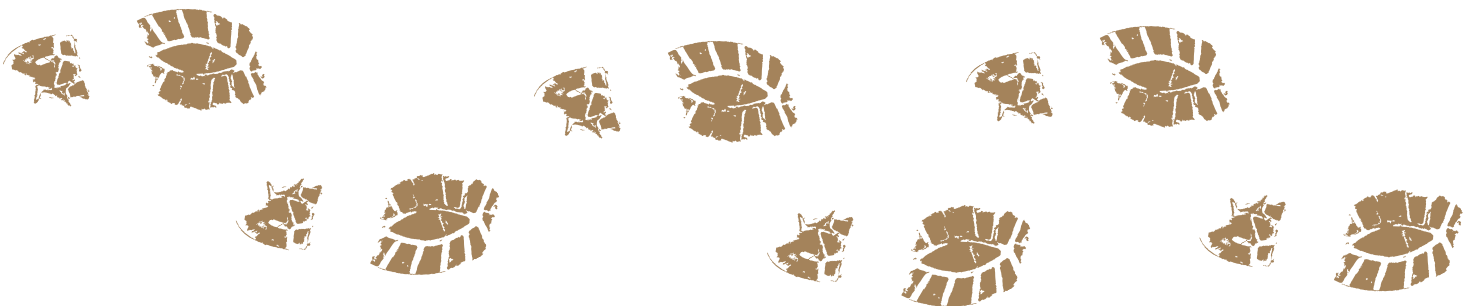

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Department of Education Parent Opinion Survey

Along with student achievement outcomes for which qualitative and quantitative data is accumulated on a daily basis, and the various CPS initiated school surveys and regular contact with parent reps, the Department of Education and Training (DET) mandate organizational surveys:

- (i) School staff survey,
- (ii) Parent opinion survey
- (iii) Attitudes to school survey (students)

Staff Opinion Survey:

CPS provides staff with numerous opportunities for growth in a well-resourced environment. This month staff are completing this survey anonymously online, with information collected from all staff in the core module of School Climate.

Parent Survey:

The Parent Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training and is designed to assist us in gaining a better understanding of parents' perceptions of school climate, student behavior and student engagement. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies. Whilst we are rightly proud of our school and must acknowledge our many achievements, we also practice a growth mindset and look for continual improvement.

Attitudes to School Survey:

We recently received the data from our student survey conducted last term with students Years 4 - 6. This data was shared in a previous email.

The 2024 Parent, Caregiver and Guardian Opinion Survey will be available to complete online from Monday 29 July to Friday 30 August 2024.

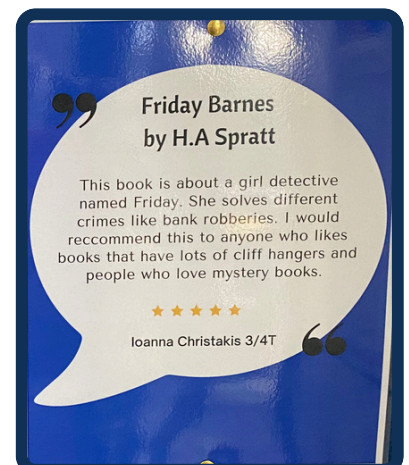
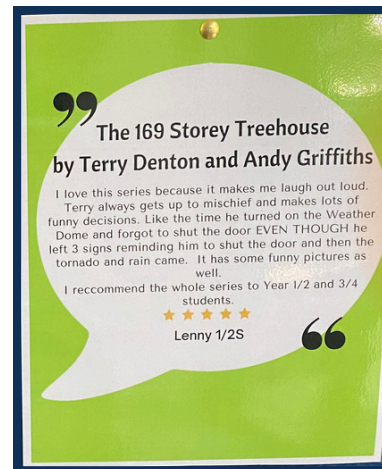
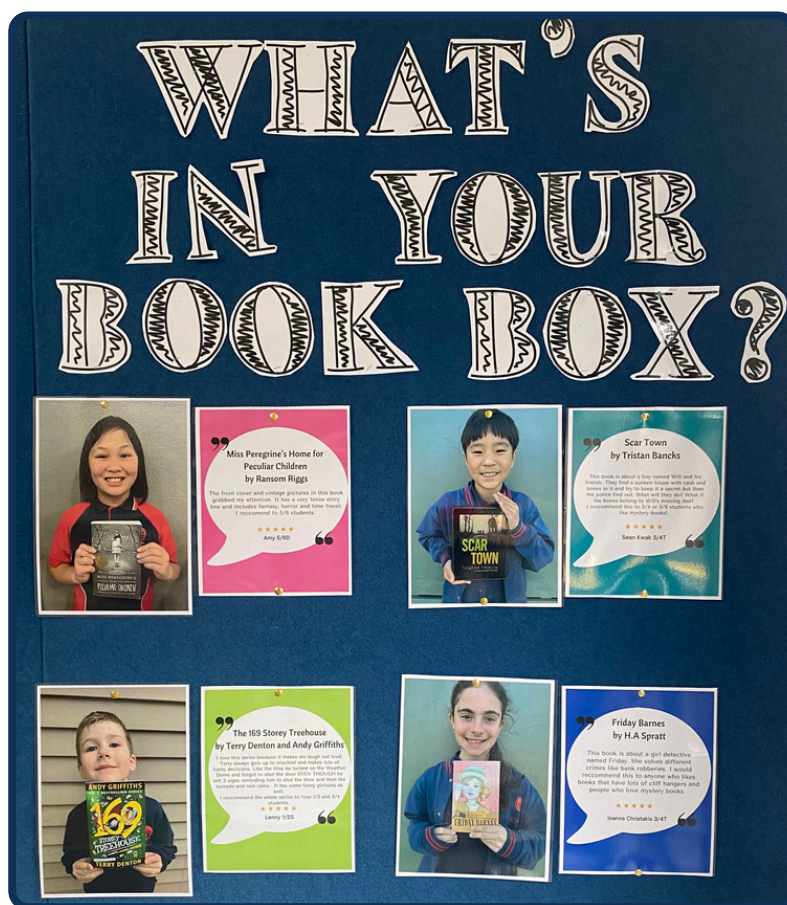
You will receive a link that will be in a compass communication.

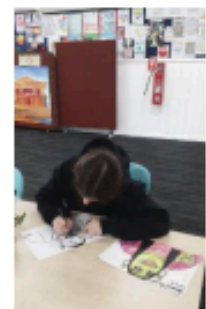
