### School Savings Bonus

The Victorian Government has delivered the School Saving Bonus (SSB), a one-off support of \$400 for eligible government school students. The SSB can be used for uniforms and school activities at any time via the school office. The credit will remain on your family statement until all funds have been used to purchase uniform or pay for school excursions/camps.

We request all families go onto the SSB online system and allocate their students funds to school activities. Please follow the Step by Step guide attached at the end of this newsletter.

If you have any questions please contact our administration team for any SSB related questions.

### CSEF

All families that hold a valid health care card can apply for the CSEF.

Camps/Sports/Excursion/Funds can be used towards any camp or excursion. It cannot be used for curriculum contributions. If the card was valid on either the first day of term 1 or term 2, each child listed on the card is eligible to receive \$154 for the year. Applications are due by the end of term 2. Those who have already applied, your funds should have already been received by our school.

Please don't hesitate to email the school or come to our main office if you have any questions regarding the above. I have attached a CSEF application form for families that hold a valid health care card and also the parent information guide for SSB.

We literally could not run the school without them! Please be sure to say a big 'Thank you' to our ES staff this week, for all that they do for our students and our school.



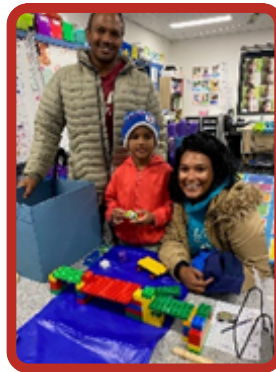

## Kiss and Go Parking

We have 'Kiss and Go' signage installed out the front of the school on Crawford Road and Eulinga Road. To assist with traffic management, it is obvious to any person using the 2-minute zone at the front of the school that it is not a place to sit and wait or leave a vehicle to go pick up children from within the school.

The process is not considered new and will be strictly monitored by Kingston Council bylaws officers. We have had a number of parents fined in recent times. For those struggling to get a car park on Crawford or Eulinga Road, may I recommend parking on Elder Street and walking across the oval with your child/ren.

### Kiss and Go Zone Process

#### 1. Stay in sequence

Drop off or pick up your child close to the top of the zone, as far forward as possible. This allows vehicles following you to enter the zone in an orderly manner.

#### 2. Curbside Entry and Exit

ALL children must enter and exit a vehicle from the curbside under no circumstances should this be from the driver's side!

#### 3. Driver duty of care

Observe traffic when entering or leaving the zone. Use your indicator to advise when moving into or out of the zone.

#### 4. Strictly No U-turns

Do not do U-turn in busy school zones. They are dangerous and put children at risk.

### 1 Register your child

Register one or more children to confirm their school and class details. We require your contact telephone number and email address to send order and payment confirmations.

You will then receive a password so that all future visits to our site are quick and easy.

### 2 Choose Menu Items to make a 2 or 3 Course Lunch

Lunch Packs start from \$6.45 for a Standard Selection 2 Course Lunch and from \$8.95 for a Standard Selection 3 Course Lunch. Lunches are delivered directly to school labelled with your child's name and class details in environmentally friendly, temperature controlled tubs.

## How to Cancel an Order

Orders can be cancelled until 9.30am on the day of delivery.

To Cancel your order – Log in to our site and click on 'My account' to view the 'Order Summary and Edit the meal you wish to cancel.

Scroll down to the 'Order Summary' area and click on 'DELETE' (the little circle with a line through it). Once you have cancelled your order our system will generate a Voucher for you to redeem when you'd like. The voucher details will be emailed to you as well as appearing in the My Account area when you log in under and scroll down to Voucher Redemption.

**Please note that Cancellations must be logged on our system prior to 9.30am on the day the order is to be delivered** - after this time the lunch will be delivered to school and available for collection.

## How to Modify an Order

Order selections can be modified until 8:30am on the day the lunch is to be delivered.

You can Edit or Cancel an order by logging in to our site and accessing the 'My Account' area.

To Modify your order - Scroll down to the 'Order Summary' area - click on 'EDIT' (the little pencil) beside the order you wish to modify and make the change. Click on Save (the tick) to update the order. You will receive an email confirming the change.

The email will contain:

- your unique School Saving Bonus code to use the \$400 support
- a link to the [School Saving Bonus parent and carer online system](#).

Parents and carers will receive one email and code for each student in their family.

If you cannot locate the email, check your spam or junk folder.

Please note, the Department of Education and the Victorian Government will never ask you to provide your banking or financial details for the School Saving Bonus.

2. Clarinda Primary School suggest that parents allocate their entire \$400 School Saving Bonus to **School Activities**.


As Clarinda Primary School operate a uniform shop **on-site**, parents can come to the office and ask for part of their \$400 to be used to purchase uniform, as they require it. You will be asked to sign a 'uniform request form' to allow the school to allocate the amount spent on uniform against your \$400 bonus.


Any funds not spent on uniform will remain in parent accounts to be used for school activities ie: camps, swimming, sport, incursions and excursions.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Can I use the SSB to purchase stationary/book packs?

There is no need as Clarinda Primary School provide all students with stationery items. The cost to the school is covered by the parent voluntary curriculum contribution.

### Do I need to tell the school when I want to use the SSB for activities (i.e. camps, swimming, sport, excursions, & incursions)?

You will be able to use the \$400 bonus to pay for camps, swimming, sport, incursions and excursions via Compass events. When an event is held, it is posted on Compass. Parents are asked at that time to consent and pay. In Compass there is an option to elect to use credit at the time of payment.

### Can I take uniforms on the day if I want to use the SSB? Yes

### Does the SSB money expire if I don't use it all in 2025?

No. The money will carry over to the following years.

### Is the SSB only able to be used for each individual sibling?

No. The SSB is allocated to the family and can be used for any student Clarinda Primary School in the immediate family.
