2026 Foundation Enrolment



Importantly, it is one small way to continue to raise the profile of primary school leaders in our society.







2025 Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents / caregivers / guardians think of our school. The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education that is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, and student engagement. The survey is optional, but we encourage all families to participate. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

In 2025 all families are invited to participate in the survey. The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey will be open from Monday 18th August to Friday 19th September.

The survey will be conducted online, only takes 20 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the survey period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese.

The results of the survey are analysed by staff and the school council who look for trends that might need addressing in the community. For example, the survey might indicate that parents and carers would like more information about an area of the school and we can then address this in the newsletter or other communications.

All families will be invited to participate in the survey and an email will be sent via Compass with a link to the survey and the school's PIN number. Families should only complete the survey once.

This week, the love language we're looking at is "words of affirmation". In communicating love, words are powerful. Words of affection, words of praise and encouragement, and words that give positive guidance all say, "I care about you". Children carry the benefit of affirming words with them for a lifetime.

Long before children understand the meaning of words, they receive emotional messages. Our tone of voice, a gentle mood and the sense of being cared for, all convey emotional warmth and love.

Our words of affirmation express appreciation for the unique person our child is. Words of praise specifically encourage a child in what they have done, either in achievements or behavior or attitudes.

Encouraging words are most effective when they are focused on a specific effort your child has made. The goal is to catch your child

doing something good and then commend him/her for it.

A few practical ideas:

- Put a Post-it note in their lunchbox with some encouraging words
- Make it a habit to say, "I love you" whenever you tuck your child in bed or leave one another
- When your child is feeling down, share 3 reasons why you are proud of them.


