

Strategic Planning for 2026

With staff movement a reality of any workforce, we are deep into our planning for 2026. Mirroring the strategic placement of teachers across the school, a great deal of thought and time goes into placing children into classes each year. Every effort is made to place each child in a learning environment that is engaging, caring and productive. As you may understand, the allocation of students to new classes is a very complex task and one that requires patience and manipulation. During this process, changes and adjustments are made over several weeks as each change triggers a chain reaction for further changes.

Are you leaving CPS in 2026?

We ask that you let us know if you are moving or have enrolled in another school in 2026. We require this information as soon as possible to establish grade structures for the start of the new school year. If your child is currently in Grades Foundation – 5, and will not be at Clarinda PS in 2025, please notify the school office in writing as soon as possible.

Parent Contributions 2026

Towards the end of this term, we will inform the school community of the Parent Payments for 2026. The Department of Education have asked schools to itemise the payments. The cost for Parent Payments is discussed and approved at our Finance and School Council meetings prior to being announced to the school community.

Prep 2026

With the strong reputation of our school, we continue to receive enrolments. Changing numbers does make locking in a class structure for the school challenging, however for the smooth transition of new Preps and their families we have begun planning for 3 Foundation classes next year. It will be terrific to meet our new parents/caregivers on Monday 13th October at the 2026 Prep Parent Information Session.

Most pleasing is the strong reputation CPS continues to rightly hold in both the local and wider community; evident in the engagement of our current Prep PLC who will make themselves available for this informative evening.
