#### **SEPEP**

The SEPEP Program is exclusive to Grade 5/6 and is run every year in Term 4. Each year, the Grade 5/6 students are split into even teams. Each student has a role in the team that is in addition to their role as a player of European Handball. The aim of the SEPEP (Sport Education in Physical Education Program) is to provide students with a more authentic sport experience — similar to what you would see in community or professional sport. Rather than just participating in isolated drills or short activities, students take on a range of roles such as players, coaches, umpires, team managers, scorers and media officers. This helps them:

- Develop teamwork, leadership and responsibility
- Build sport-specific skills and tactical understanding
- Learn about fair play, respect and the values of sport




